As the East and South East Regional Officer my role is to support individuals with disfigurements, and their families, by providing advice and self-help information, and to signpost people to appropriate local specialist services (where available), workshops and family events in collaboration with Changing Faces staff and local services e.g. a specialist NHS clinic for children with cleft lip and/or palates. More recently there was the Harry Potter Themed Day at Addenbrooke's for children with a Cleft Lip and /or Palate to build confidence and self esteem. I also want to extend networking, sharing knowledge and raising awareness about disfigurement and an understanding of our work with national/regional condition-specific support groups e.g. CLAPA Cambridge and voluntary sector organisations, including those in Black and Ethnic Minority communities. Changing Faces wants to radically improve the quality and quantity of information and support available to individuals and families who experience disfigurement wherever they live in the UK – thereby breaking the cycle of isolation for those who could benefit from support and advice but may not have heard of the charity and our services and campaigns. There are four Regional Officers covering the UK in the North, Midlands, South and South West and me Samantha Denyer covering the South and South East. There are also 3 Country Officers working in Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales. Each Officer liaises very closely with patients and support groups, professionals in the health sector, education, government and the media, and I look forward to building a relationship with CLAPA Cambridge in this new role. The next event is the launch of the South and East Service on 30th March 2010 at Addenbrooke's Hospital starting at 11.30am in the main concourse where you can pick up some information about Changing Faces and the new Children's Face Equality campaign then moving to the Frank Lee Centre for light refreshments a visit by Dr Mary Archer and chance for you to lend your face to the campaign.
